

## PA1 - The Safe Use of Pesticides

### Course information:

This intensive theoretical course prepares candidates to take their City & Guilds NPTC PA1 Foundation Module Assessment.

We register our PA1 courses with both NRoSO and BASIS as many of our customers supply supermarkets and membership of these organisations is often a supplier or assurance scheme requirement.
